2016 Growth and Accomplishments

2016 marked milestone growth for The Scott Foundation. We scaled up our operations more formally, allowing us to better share the inspiring work of the organizations we support, provide a platform for our organizations to access resources, and help donors connect with organizations that align with their values. We are especially proud of the following accomplishments:

- **Website launch:** in May, we launched our foundation website, thescottfoundation.org, to showcase each grantee, provide an easy way for grantseekers to submit their applications, and share a running tally of our impact.
- **Social media:** in May, we also launched a Facebook page which we use to share information about our grantees' work, fundraisers, events and photos, as well as informational articles about our priority funding areas and foundation updates.
- **Steward donations:** in July, we added donation functionality to our website so that we can connect donors with organizations we support. We hope to leverage donated funds for match/challenge grants.
